Playing Ability

Playing ability is an assessment of how your junior knows and plays the game of golf. This encompasses not only the physical ability, but also the mental and social ability on the course. We have categorized our playing ability into 5 groups to allow you and our staff to properly place your junior in the most appropriate programs we offer. Here is our distinction of each level:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Juniors who are familiar with the game of golf, rules, etiquette, and speed of play. We have blue forward tees on each hole of our regulation course marked in the fairway and on cart paths.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Juniors who are familiar with the game of golf, rules, etiquette, and speed of play. We have yellow forward tees on each hole of our regulation course marked in the fairway and on cart paths.
